Our drinking water comes entirely from groundwater wells—it's pumped out of the ground and then disinfected with sodium hypochlorite, the primary disinfectant found in household bleach, an excellent chemical for killing bacteria and viruses.

According to the EPA, "the presence of the COVID-19 virus has not been detected in drinking-water supplies and, based on current evidence, the risk to water supplies is low." As always, our #1 job is to deliver clean, safe drinking water, and our #1 concern is our customers' health.
