To Carol Conant, a resident of the Town of Weld in the County of Franklin, State of Maine.

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the said Town qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet on Friday, MAY 29, 2026 A.D. at 6:30 PM to act upon ARTICLE 1 through ARTICLE 6 as set out below, to wit.

The registrar gives notice that she or her designate will be at the Town Hall at 17 School Street to register new voters at 5:30 PM of the day of the said meeting being Friday, May 29<sup>th</sup> and to correct the check list.

**Article 1:** To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

**Article 2:** Proposed Amendment to Annual Town Meeting Article 19: To see if the Town will amend Article 19 from the March 7, 2026 Annual Town Meeting as passed, to clarify that the effect of such Article is to raise and appropriate during the 2026 budget year a total of \$35,000 in reference to General Government line-item E-10-100-21 Re-evaluation as listed in the 2026 Annual Town Meeting Planning Workbook in the non-lapsing reserve account, for purposes of saving for a town-wide property re-evaluation (estimated at the cost of \$104,880), to be conducted by John E. O'Donnell & Associates Inc. starting Summer/Fall 2027.

Note: This amendment is necessary to correct the funding amount specified in the 2026 Annual Town Meeting Warrant. While the current language authorizes \$70,000, the intended appropriation supported by both the Select Board and Budget Committee is \$35,000. Approval of this amendment will align the article with the planned budget.

**Article 3:** To see if the Town will vote to authorize payment of \$2,628.34 to Calderwood Engineering, LLC for LRAP Kennedy Bridge Repair/Replacement (Acct E-36-800-12) from LRAP General Fund (Acct G-01-700-00) for the final payment for the Kennedy Bridge Project billed 2/23/26.

**Article 4:** To see if the Town will authorize the Public Works Department to purchase a 48" Tilt Bucket, a 48" Flail Mower Brush Cutter, and an 8.5'x25' Trailer for the 23 Excavator. These purchases shall be funded using up to \$27,000 from the 2026 Annual Town Meeting Planning Workbook line-item E-31-500-00 (Vehicle & Equipment Maintenance) and up to \$2,085.34 from line-item E-31-500-09 (PW 23 Excavator) and shall not to exceed \$29,0085.34 in total.

Note: This article does not request new funding. It serves to clarify the specific equipment intended for purchase under the previously appropriated Vehicle & Equipment Maintenance budget listed in the 2026 Annual Town Meeting Planning Workbook.

**Article 5:** To see if the Town will authorize the Town of Weld Treasurer to pay the following expenditures over \$10,000:

- a. Maine Health-FMH Ambulance Contract (May and December) - \$15,295.00
- b. Communications Consulting-Radios (May)- \$10,629.60
- c. RSU 9 Monthly Payment (April) - \$54,992.20
- d. RSU 9 Monthly Payment (May) – \$54,992.20
- e. RSU 9 Monthly Payment (June) – (estimated \$55,000.00)
- f. RSU 9 Monthly Payment (July) – (estimated \$55,000.00)
- g. Androscoggin Bank-15 Ford Payment (June) - \$13,097.87
- h. Kennedy Bridge Bond (October) \$38,860.65
- i. Weld Winter Wildcats grant reimbursement \$18,241.75


Note: This article does not request new funding. It serves to clarify that these expenditures were approved at the 2026 Annual Town meeting and authorizes the required payments exceeding \$10,000.

**Article 6:** To see if the Town will authorize the Select Board to borrow the necessary funds from time to time to be repaid by federal reimbursement for purposes of the Multi-Recreation Space Project approved in Articles 10 and 11 at the March 7, 2026 Annual Town Meeting.


