OLD BUSINESS

1. Calderwood Engineering - West Brook Bridge update
2. Barbie Castonguay – Website update: Vendor Findings/Proposals
3. Open Position on RSU9 School Board effective July1, 2026
4. Dummer's Beach liens – we cannot release the liens until the taxes are paid by the owners or we abate the taxes.
5. Tax acquired property
6. 88 School St. – The new name for the road is Rock Gate. The name has been approved by the land owners and the new 911 addresses have been given to the owners, 911 Emergency, and the Post Office.
7. FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG), Fire Prevention & Safety (FP&S), and Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) Grants – Becky Vining, Barbie Castonguay, Ernestine Hutchinson, and Corey Hutchinson have been working on the application for this grant for the Fire Department.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Annual Chicken BBQ and Street Dance will be held Saturday July 4, 2026. The Weld Winter Wildcats have talked with Franklin Co. Sheriff's Dept. for the street closure. Weld Fire Rescue will be responsible for blocking off the section of Mill St. from the center of town to the TOPO during the event.

2. Sean Minear has talked to the DOT concerning a crosswalk at the Historical Buildings near Weld Corners. He would also like to have “No Parking” signs placed along the road at this site, which would require a town ordinance.
3. Free Dump Day at the Transfer Station – June 28th, July 1st, and July 5th
4. Maine Waste Action Corp. contract – the contract needs to be signed to continue services concerning delivery of municipal solid waste, pricing and capacity to the waste-to-energy facility.
5. Multi-Purpose room agreement and fees – discussion to amend the usage agreement fees.
6. 4-H Program in Weld – April Demers would like to start a 4-H Club in the town of Weld. She has requested the use of the Multi-Purpose Room for meetings twice monthly, as well as using the tennis court and the ball field on occasion. Insurance would be provided through 4-H.
7. Weld Fire rescue fee – Weld Fire recently had another Tumbledown call where the “lost hiker” demonstrated poor decision making. Fire Chief Corey Hutchinson has asked again about the possibility of billing for such calls. An ordinance would be required.
8. Weld Recreation appointments – signatures required for volunteer forms
