NEW BUSINESS

1. Retirement Party for 2 Town employees - Weld Rec would like to create a sub-committee to plan and execute the party. Several people have voiced interest in helping on the committee.
2. Appoint Richard Dougherty as RSU 9 School Board representative.
3. Planning Board – It has been suggested that the Planning Board meet bi-monthly during the summer months (June, July, and August) beginning in 2027. Michael Stephenson CEO has discussed this with the Planning Board members. Update from Mike Stephenson.
4. Veteran's Monument name addition – the Town has had a Veteran's Monument form filled out for review for a name to be added to the Vietnam Veteran's monument.
5. The Town is receiving a new vote tabulator machine for the upcoming elections. The SB needs to sign the user agreement.
6. Park Passes/ Camp Kawanhee – The treasurer has tried several times to contact Kawanhee to see if they are going to donate money to the Town for State Park passes. Kawanhee did not donate monies last year, but the Town had enough money in the account to purchase the passes for 2026. Currently there is \$65 in the account for park passes.
7. Sand Stockpile bids have been sent out for the 2026-2027 winter season. All bids are due October 1, 2026 for SB approval. The sand must be in place by November 1, 2026.
