#### Farmington Underground

Joseph Musumeci pursued his dream of opening an escape room by establishing Farmington Underground in February of 2018 in downtown Farmington.

Motivated by the desire to provide a unique, interactive experience and outlet of fun for groups of friends and family, Musumeci created an exciting room full of puzzles to solve. Players go from clue to clue opening locked boxes, interacting with props and scenery while following along with a story, eventually winning the game by solving the mystery.

Drawing inspiration from different games and being interested in how people interacted with them, Musumeci thought that creating his own escape room would be a fun, unique and positive way that friends, family and even co-workers could work together and overcome challenges.

He is currently working on building a second room with a medieval theme scheduled to be opened this summer that ties in with the theme of a time traveling secret society.

Farmington Underground is a one-of-a-kind experience and the only escape room in this part of the state of Maine. 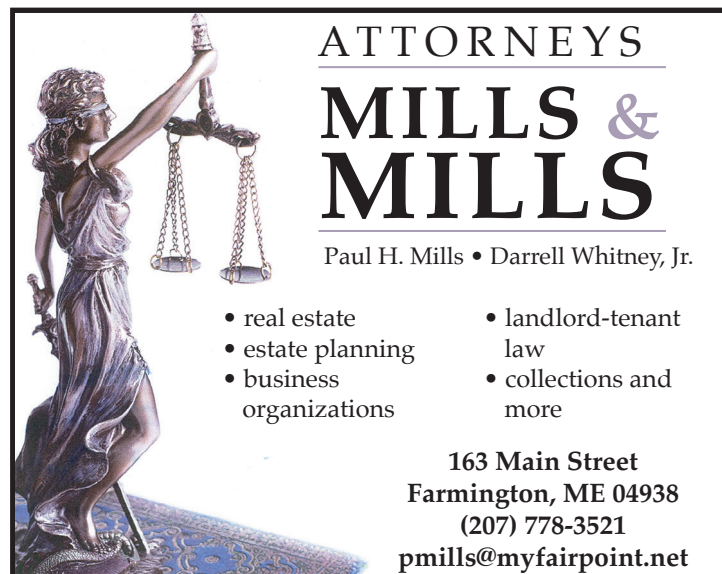

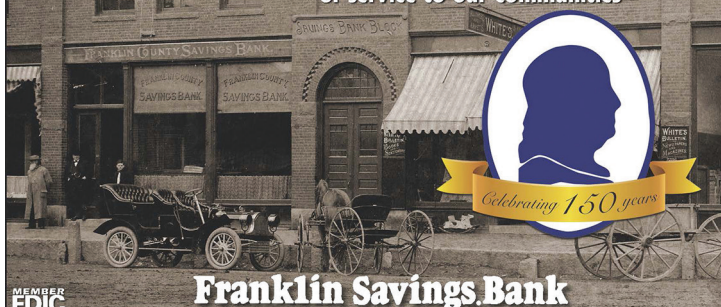

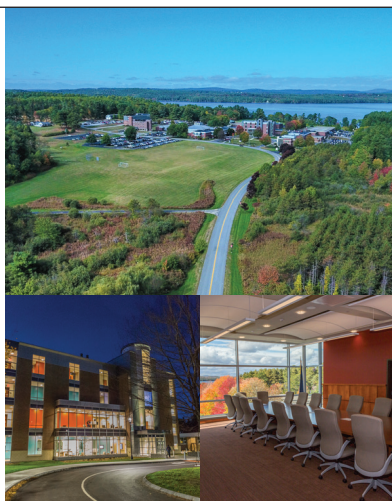
