All 4 on the Floor Dog Training

All 4 on the Floor Dog Training is Owned/Operated by Lisa Berry in Phillips, Maine. She is a certified dog trainer using Positive Reinforcement Training for dogs 8 weeks and older. Lisa offers private lessons in the convenience of your own home, along with obedience group classes and the AKC S.T.A.R Puppy program. She is an AKC Canine Good Citizens Evaluator and has Instructor testing/certification for Therapy/Service Dogs.

Lisa's interest in training dogs started 13 years ago when she got her first puppy. When the puppy was 8 weeks old, she called a dog trainer and asked if the pup was too young to start obedience training. The trainer said "not at all." Keeping dogs active and socialized is very important for a happy and healthy dog. After getting 2 more labs and training them, Lisa went to Animal Behavioral College to become a Certified Dog Trainer, along with further certification for Shelter Dog training, Diet & Nutrition, Animal First Aid and CPR.

With her training in the medical field as an LPN (18 years), being Hospice Certified and her Medical Records experience, she was qualified to become a Certified Service Dog Trainer for TADSAW (Train a Dog save a Warrior organization). This is the program that Lisa is most proud to work with. She can offer this at no charge to Veterans Active Duty, Retired, Discharged with PTSD, MIADS, TBI, MST. This is a 15-25 week training program. Lisa's passion for helping veterans came from having a grandfather in the Army, a daughter in the Young Marines and 2 uncles in the Marines. She saw what they did for our country, fighting wars for us and serving our country. Lisa wanted to give something back to our veterans.
